Father Forgive Them...'

Returning home from a wedding reception last Friday evening I could not believe my eyes when I saw the dark rising smoke, the flashing blue lights of several fire brigades and the large crowd that had gathered. My heart began to race. When I got out of my car and ran to the scene a firefighter approached and spoke these reassuring words '*I think we have it under control!*'' You can imagine my relief.

The people of the parish and wider community have been hurt and saddened by this arson attack- as revealed by our security camerasbecause this Church of the Holy Family is a sacred space where so many have celebrated key moments in their lives together with those who come here to pray and worship. But as the saying goes 'hurt people, hurt people'. What is the hurt in the hearts of the arsonists who did this to their people? What parenting did they have or lack? What joy could they get from causing such pain? We prayed for the perpetrators at Mass last We have forgiven them. While I have heard much weekend. understandable anger it is important to forgive and let go, in order to know that peace to which Christ refers in last Sunday's Gospel. Another important lesson for me in all of this is that of detachment from things of this world and not letting these things we think we own -or more properly 'have on loan for a while'- possess us. What freedom we enjoy when we can say, in the spirit of St. Francis, 'I claim possession of nothing.'

In any tragedy - and let us remember it is a tragedy with a small 't' – it is good to look at the hidden positives. Firstly, that no one was killed or injured. Also that the church and parochial house, though damaged, were saved thanks to the swift actions of the fire service under the excellent leadership of parishioner and fire chief Adrian Cooper. (I remember baptising his children in this same church and writing his reference when he first applied for that fireman's job many years ago!).
