CORPUS CHRISTI

During the last meal of his earthly life Jesus charged his disciples to keep his memory alive by gathering together to break bread. Whatever else they do, his followers must remember to eat in his name. 'Do this in memory of me.'

Let us pray that our young people will again find a hunger for the Eucharist. Most of us don't have to remember to eat: our stomach's hunger pangs have



their own way of telling us when it's time. But we do have to remember to eat in the name of Jesus – which is why the Church asks us to gather in community each week to keep the memory of Jesus alive. We assemble in gratitude to hold that memory sacred and relive his saving death and resurrection. We also recall Jesus' radical values that put him in opposition to so many of his own people: his talk about another Kingdom; his insistence on a new way to live; his opposition to the self-righteous Pharisees; his willingness to die to overcome sin. In receiving the body and blood of Christ we become his body in our world. Nourished and fortified by the Bread of Life we are challenged each Sunday to build up that Kingdom during the following week, a Kingdom of mercy and compassion, of justice , love and peace.
