HEY MISTER ARE YOU A PRIEST?

[The title of his first book]

When I was ordained a priest in 1973 I was sent to St. Eugene's Cathedral to replace the then Fr Daly who had gone to work as director of Religious Affairs at RTE in Dublin. Those were big shoes to fill because he was such a pastoral priest with '*the smell of the sheep*' as Pope Francis puts it.

He got the job because of his skill in dealing with the media after Bloody Sunday and was relatively unknown before then. A year later he was made bishop and chose 'feed my sheep' as his coat of arms. Before this bishops were usually chosen from heads of the local Catholic Secondary schools run by diocesan priests or had a degree usually in Canon Law. Bishop Edward had none of these qualifications but his choice was truly inspired for he became the ' Beloved Pope of Derry' until his health failed in 1994. He was a tireless worker, motivated by a zeal for his new episcopal calling and that enthusiasm was contagious. I can remember clearly how his new vocation and mine ran parallel-he was on fire with a love of God and his people and so was I. When I saw him in hospital two weeks ago I thanked him for his inspiration and the excitement of those early years. In spite of the troubles the diocese was buzzing. It soon set the standard for the other dioceses to try to follow. This parish was the last in a whole series of new parishes he formed in the city.
