She is extremely thankful to get a transplant so quickly and also for the fact she will no longer require dialysis treatment. Jim's other kidney was given to a man in his forties. He is still an inpatient but has made great progress and is expected to be discharged within the next couple of days.

A man in his forties received Jim's heart. His medical team tell us he is making slow but steady progress.

Let us follow Jim's example and register as organ donors. May he rest in peace.
