PRAYER

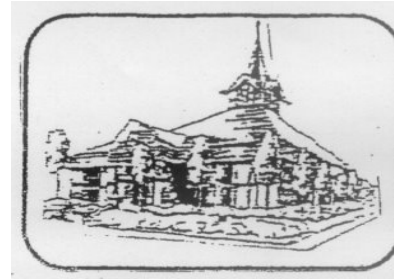
Before the end of day, Lord,
