### FINANCE MEETING

At our last Finance Council meeting it was projected that we will have a shortfall of around £11,000 at the end of the year. This is due partly to the fact that we no longer have a parish draw or parish savings. It is also caused by a fall -off in the weekend collections. When the holidays are over we will address this matter from the pulpit and by a written appeal.

It is also decided to have a big annual draw. Many other parishes have done this to replace parish savings and weekly draw. It was also suggested that the Pastoral Council would consider have a mission next year.

Approval was given for work to be done at the side of the church facing Dunne's car park. This work will start hopefully this week and the work will be done by Peninsula Construction. The fir trees between the church and school are causing a problem and will also be cut back this week. We thank you for your generosity in the past and know you will respond to this appeal in due course
