The firstó that we should love God.

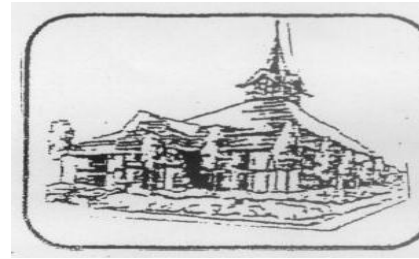
The secondó that we should love our neighbour.
