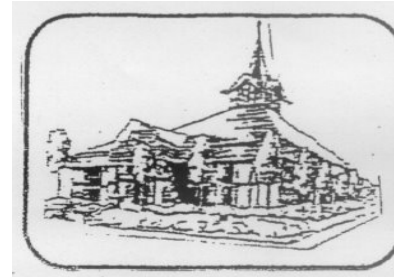

We live in a age of manifestos
providing a summary of policies and
strategies which, afterwards, can be
used to measure achievements and
failures. In the Synagogue at
Nazareth Jesus presents the manifesto
for his ministry when he read an
extract from the prophet Isaiah and
comments 'this text is being fulfilled
today even as you listen'



This can only have one meaning: Isaiah's prophecy was being fulfilled in Jesus' person and in his Church. This means that people regarded as meaningless by society before this are now the people of Jesus Christ. It is these people to whom the text of Isaiah refers to as fulfilled in the person of Jesus Christ and continues to be so in his Church.

It is important to remember that the Church's role in society is not just sacramental or prayerful. From Pentecost the Church has engaged in the work of social justice. Perhaps in the future this role in will be the work of lay people. Not so that the Church can control society or seek to have power in society; rather because in doing so the Church is fulfilling the mandate set her by Christ in Nazareth, as he fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah.
