DISCOVERING ONE'S OWN RICHES

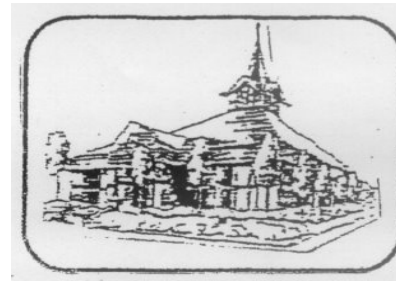
I lived on the shady side of
