Mark Burnett is regarded as one of the pioneers of Reality T.V. and is a big name in Hollywood. He and his wife Roma Downey are in the process of producing a series on the Bible which will be screened next year.

In his autobiography he describes how one of the keys to his success has been his trust in his intuition and to go ahead unfettered by the insecurity which causes many to hesitate.

The title of his book is '*Jump In*'. That phrase reappeared last year at the seminar weekend in Ards last year when we were preparing for our Pastoral Council. We were told how Moses hesitated when he come to the Red Sea but Nashun 'jumped in' and the waters parted.

At our Pastoral Council meeting last Thursday we had our first Nashun moment when we appointed our firsts sub-committee - to deal with marriage and family life. They will co-opt others who will then, as a Core group, in due course form subcommittees to deal with baptism and marriage preparation, parenting issues, family prayer and bereavement.
